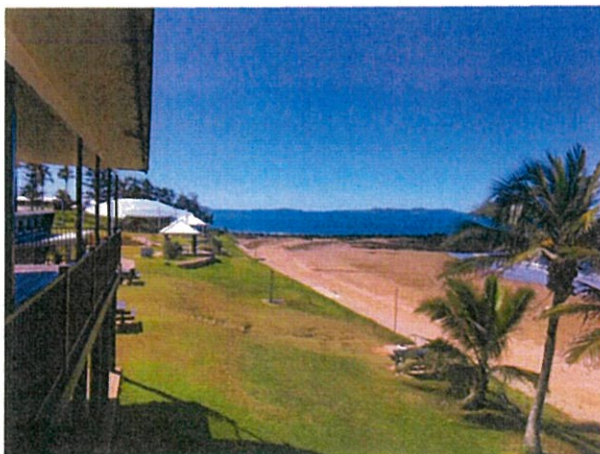

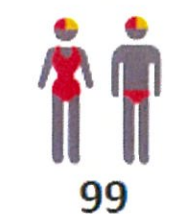




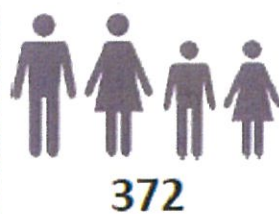

## **Emu Park SLSC Report**

### **2019/2020 Season**

On May Day, the 2019/2020 Surf Life Saving season ended with the last patrol. This season started out brilliantly, with a vast increase in Nipper and other members, so that the club was at a strength over 350 members. We were all extremely optimistic at the start of the season.

However, COVID-19 put a stop to the competition season, to our Nippers, and forced the club into surveillance patrols. Although a disappointing end to the season, it is hoped that the members have enjoyed more time with their family and will return reinvigorated for the 2020/2021 season.

### **2020/2021 Season**

As the Queensland school holidays commence on Friday 18 September 2020, the first Nipper day will, subject to any COVID-19 restrictions, commence at 9:00am Sunday 20 September 2020. We would welcome all past members to attend on that day or our sign on days on Sunday 6 and 13 September 2020 at 9:00am.

Prior to that, on Sunday 5 July 2020, our club will hold its annual general meeting. We welcome the attendance of all members. We will comply with the social distancing rules then in place. At the AGM our longstanding club captain Natasha Wilkinson and our hardworking CTO Shane Tapp will stand down. All members would like to thank Tash for the countless hours of work she has put in, including doing the Christmas day patrol for a number of years. Tappy has been great CTO and our club is poorer for the loss of these two executive members. The onerous obligations imposed upon our volunteers does lead to them being burnt out and it is something that needs to be addressed.

In the 2020/2021 season we will conduct the junior branch titles at Emu Park and we look forward to seeing all the other clubs at our beach.

### **Clubhouse Renovations**

On 7 May 2020, the committee accepted the quote of Swebworthy Constructions Pty Ltd for the renovation of the old two storey portion of our clubhouse. The works have commenced and will be completed in August. The works are extensive, including the construction of a new café to be operated by Honey Bee Collective out of the existing canteen area from 29 August. In addition we will construct a new canteen kitchen where the old offices were situated. This is a most exciting venture and will provide us with a good start to the new season.

### **Renovation/Repair Boat Shed**

Brittany Lauga MP, has provided significant assistance to the club in order to obtain a grant from the Queensland government under the Active Community Infrastructure Project. This is a million dollar government grant which will allow for the demolition and reconstruction of the boat shed gear storage area and associated works including the construction of new female amenities, disabled amenities, and reconstruction of the men's amenities.

The committee has undertaken a great deal of investigation and received expert advice upon this most significant project. The favoured design differs from that which has been previously published and is available on the club notice board for those who wish to view it. The Deed of Grant which has been signed between the Queensland Government and club officials provides for the demolition and reconstruction of the gear shed facility between October 2020 and 30 June 2021. Our consultants, architects, engineers, and building certifiers with associated town planning advice suggest that such a time line is feasible. The current committee has been working extremely hard to ensure that these projects are undertaken and I would like to thank all of our committee, but particularly John Phelan, Zane Hooten and Gavin Reynolds for their attendance at numerous meetings to ensure that these projects become a reality.

A special thank you also to Bendigo Bank Emu Park and Yeppoon for their continued generous support. I would also like to thank Michelle McRae and Ted McLeod for the fantastic work which they do for surf sports. Our nippers are run brilliantly by Kurt and Brooke Goodwin leading a team of dedicated age managers. I would like to thank all our volunteer members.

I look forward to another exciting season in 2020/2021, hopefully with a lot less restrictions and seeing our club back running at full capacity.

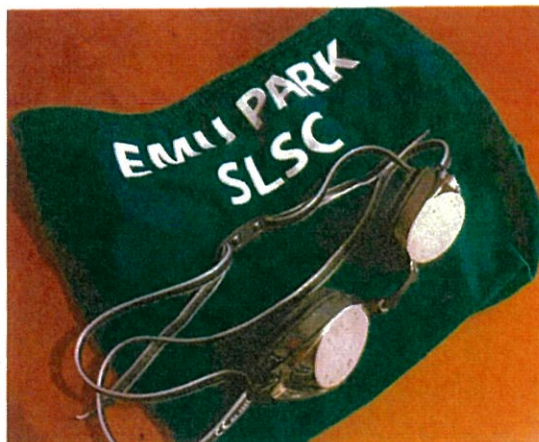

### Surf Sports Are For Everyone:

This season, we initiated a couple of activities to help bring our club together and promote surf sports:

#### Parkie Breaky Beach Run

We ran 6 Parkie Breaky Beach Runs throughout the season, with between 10 & 20 runners taking part each time. Runners could choose their distance (1,2 or 3km) and their times, inc. split times, were recorded



to track improvements as the season progressed. These runs are open to active & non-active members and take place on Nipper Sundays, starting at 8am sharp to allow enough time for pancake breakfast (kindly donated by our Club) before Nippers started.

#### Clubbie Swim:

Again on Nipper Sundays, following the completion of the Nipper program, an open invite short distance swim (not sprint!) was organised for any club member / parent wanting to participate in a short social swim of roughly 200m (or 400m for those wanting to do 2 laps). Again numbers ranged from 10 – 20 and it was good to see different faces giving it a crack.

#### Australia Day Holiday Ocean Swim:

### **NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2020**

#### **NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act Queensland. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

**a. Income Tax**

The association is exempt from Income Tax in terms of Section 50-40 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997 as amended.

**b. Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)**

Property, Plant and equipment are carried at cost where applicable.

Plant and equipment is not depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association but carried at cost until the Management Committee determine that the assets become obsolete.

**c. Impairment of Assets**

At the end of each reporting period, the entity reviews the carrying amounts of its tangible and intangible assets to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have been impaired. If such an indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs to sell and value in use, is compared to the asset's carrying amount. Any excess of the asset's carrying amount over its recoverable amount is recognised in the income and expenditure statement.

**d. Provisions**

Provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

**e. Cash and Cash Equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at call with banks, and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.

**f. Revenue and Other Income**

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable after taking into account any trade discounts and volume rebates allowed. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest method, which for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument. Dividend revenue is recognised when the right to receive a dividend has been established.

Grant and donation income is recognised when the entity obtains control over the funds, which is generally at the time of receipt.



### **INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT TO THE MEMBERS**

#### **OF EMU PARK SURF LIFE SAVING CLUB INC.**

#### **Qualified Opinion**

We have audited the accompanying financial report, being a special purpose financial report, of Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc. (the association), which comprises the assets and liabilities statement as at 30 April 2020, the income and expenditure statement for the year then ended, notes comprising a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information, and the statement by members of the committee.

In our opinion, subject to the effects if any, on the financial report of the matters referred to in the qualification paragraph, the financial report presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc. as at 30 April 2020 and its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act Queensland.

#### **Basis for Qualified Opinion**

It is not practicable for Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc to establish accounting control over the cash receipt of fundraising income prior to banking. Accordingly, it is not possible for our examination to include audit procedures to extend beyond the amounts of such income recorded in the accounting records of Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc.

We were appointed as auditors of Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc during the year ended 30 April 2020. We were unable to obtain access to the auditor working papers of the prior year auditor, Benson Accountants to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence about opening balances (as at, and for the year ended 30 April 2019) and were unable to perform alternate procedures relating to these balances. Consequently, we were unable to determine whether any adjustments to opening balances were necessary, which may impact on the financial performance or position of the Association for the year ended 30 April 2020..

We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report section of our report. We are independent of Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc. in accordance with the ethical requirements of the Accounting Professional and Ethical Standards Board's APES 110 Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (the Code) that are relevant to our audit of the financial report in Australia. We have also fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion

#### **Emphasis of Matter – Basis of Accounting**

We draw attention to Note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial report has been prepared to assist Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc. to meet the requirements of the applicable legislation. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

#### **Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Report**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in accordance with the financial reporting requirements of the applicable legislation and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation and fair presentation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial report, management is responsible for assessing Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc.'s ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate Emu Park Surf Life Saving Club Inc. or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Rockhampton Water Polo Association Inc.'s financial reporting process.

#### **Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report**

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial report as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
