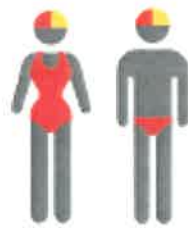

## 2021 - 2022 Season | President's Report | Emu Park SLSC

---

The success our club achieved last season is best observed in the photograph of our club members taken after the branch titles. Our senior club won every trophy at the branch. That type of success comes not only through the extraordinary efforts of our athletes, but also the efforts of all of our senior members. At our branch championships, Emu Park had approximately half the competitors, with some senior members donning the green and white cap for the first time in many years.

There is great strength in numbers. There has been a rapid increase in the size of our club since the 2019 season in which we had a total membership of 318. That increased by 17% to 372 in the 2020 year and then increased again by a further 17% to 436 in the 2021 year and has again increased by 23% to 535 in the 2022 year. We are the largest club in the branch and currently the most successful club in the branch.

This success is built upon our numerous enthusiastic members and the efforts by our very hardworking committee. There have been so many successful projects, so many grants obtained, so much success in sports surf. I would like to thank the club deputy president, Craig Beevers for his tireless work on many projects including the very popular club legend day. Many thanks to our club captain, Dr Jordon Irwin who was a standout club captain this season and we welcome Brittany Hooton, currently club vice-captain, into the role of club captain next season. Thanks to the hard-working club secretary Gavin Reynolds and the club treasurer Zane Hooton. Thanks to our retiring chief training officer, Keran Maguire OAM and welcome to our incoming chief training officer, Emma Chambers and her deputy Courtney Blamires. Thanks to Michelle McRae for her excellent work as our surf sports officer and publicity officer; our publicity is first class. I would like to thank our club coach, Ted McLeod, first aid officer Quintin Smith, and our hardworking registrar Janenne Hooton. Our outstanding junior activities coordinator, Kurt Goodwin, is stepping down after many years in this demanding role Kurt and Brooke are awesome contributors to our club. It is extremely important in a successful club, such as ours, that people are prepared to put their hand up when we have a change in the management committee. It is therefore extremely pleasing to see Guy Gennings step up to the role of junior activities coordinator. Thank you, Guy. I would also like to thank Stirling Kidd for stepping up into the role as clubhouse director. Our club is in terrific shape, however, it needs constant attention to maintenance in order to keep it in that condition. Although our club has many laurels to rest upon, our committee will continue to strive hard to ensure that our club improves.

Our club is extremely fortunate to have numerous sponsors. We have numerous tent sponsors and equipment sponsors. Special mention should be made of the sponsorship by Mr Kevin Doolan of the Professionals Real Estate, Emu Park, who approached our club and offered to sponsor our club and has contributed more than \$10,000 in sponsorship in the last few months. This has assisted in the purchase of one of our two new double skis as well as a more than 50% contribution towards the irrigation project around our club which will immensely improve the amenity of our club. You will notice that we have a new set of aluminium board racks for our nippers. Our club thanks Pat O'Driscoll Real Estate for sponsoring those.

In addition to the two new double skis our club has purchased two new single skis, some second-hand skis and other sports surf equipment. Our growing club needs adequate equipment, and the committee is endeavouring to ensure that all members have access to equipment to allow them to carry out their duties as lifesavers and engage in surf sports.

Our club was among the first to apply to SLSQ for the provision of a jet ski water rescue service and that remains a work in progress. Our club has registered several of its members to undertake the drone training for the operation of drones in the new season. Our club has engaged closely with our community, assisting Livingstone Shire Council with the delivery of



the Mobi Mat and beach wheelchair. A big thanks to the Iwasaki Foundation Limited for their sponsorship of these items. We continue to provide water safety for the Frogs triathlon club and increased our participation in the iconic Emu Park Anzac dawn service with an oar salute from our surf boat. Thank you to Justin O'Donoghue and all the boaties for their hard work this year.

Our dedicated surf sports members, led by coach Ted McLeod, had a terrific year this year. Apart from our success at the branch, Emu Park had an extremely large contingent attending at both the state and Australian Championships. Our club had one of the largest, if not the largest, participation by a provincial club in both the State and Australian Championships and it is something that we ought to be proud of. At the Australian Championships this year, there were terrific results by Brittany Hooton, Taitum Harney and Terry Beaton.

The 2023 season will bring some challenges including attendance by sufficiently large number of senior members at the branch championships at Hervey Bay to enable us to attempt to preserve our position as the premier club in the branch as well as attendance at Scarborough Beach, Perth, at the Australian Championships next March. The club will work towards a successful program for surf sports in the 2023 season and I encourage each member to consider joining our surf sports program. We have excellent coaching, without any training fees, which is most unusual in surf lifesaving or sports generally.

Finally, I would like to thank Katie Connor of the Honey Bee Collective for everything she does. Not only is Katie a major financial supporter of our club, she brings a great deal of happiness, kindness and enjoyment to our club and to our community. Please bring your family and friends to Emu Park to support her business both in lifesaving season and now outside the season. The only place in the world better than Emu Park in the summer is Emu Park on a sunny winter's day, so come down.

## JAC Report for 2022 Annual Report

I would like to thank the 2021/22 junior sub-committee. Throughout the season we have welcomed a large number of new families who have become involved in the club and once again our returning families have been a tremendous support to the program. It is extremely encouraging to see the involvement of our parents in the younger age groups on nipper mornings. Our nippers program has been highly engaging and has produced many great results for individuals.

### **Our Success:**

This year, we:

1. Largest increase in nipper membership in decades with 214 junior members;
2. Awarded 184 age awards including six surf rescue certificates;
3. Had strong competition participation at local, branch, state and national levels;
4. Developed our graduating under 14's into surf lifesaving patrolling members;
5. Encouraged our nippers to enjoy Fun, Family and Friendship each weekend.
6. New awards were achieved by our parents including SRC and officials' qualifications

### **North Aussies**

This year the club took a large number of competitors to the North Aussie Championships. For the first time in over 5 years the club took a boat crew which was made up of a large number of nipper parents. The event held in Mackay is the first major carnival of the year it was a great way for the nippers to compete early in the season with a high standard of competition. Thank you to our parents and officials and water safety for volunteering to help. Congratulations to Micaela Harney and Charlie Kidd for making the Queensland Country Team this year.

### **North v South Rep Team**

North V South was cancelled this season due to the ongoing withdrawal of athletes due to COVID 19. With over 20 changes across both teams the decision to cancel the event was made.

### **Junior Branch**

The Wide Bay Capricorn Junior Branch titles were held at Bundaberg SLSC. While the carnival was a long one our athletes came away with many medals. Thanks to our volunteers we fulfilled all of our IRB, water safety and officials' responsibilities. We had great success both at an individual level and within team events bringing home a swag of medals.

### **State Titles**

Youth States this year was to be held at Alexandra Headlands. Due to extreme weather the carnival was cancelled after the beach runs on Thursday afternoon. A team of 33 athletes went to compete but left regretting not being able to get into the water.

### **Australian Youth Championships**

A small number of nippers headed south to North Kirra for the Youth Championships. Due to COVID restrictions cancelling the event last year, this was the first time at Aussies for both under 14 & 15 competitors. This year four nippers went to the championships. While we didn't come away with medals all of our athletes competed well and enjoyed the opportunity to compete against the best in Australia.

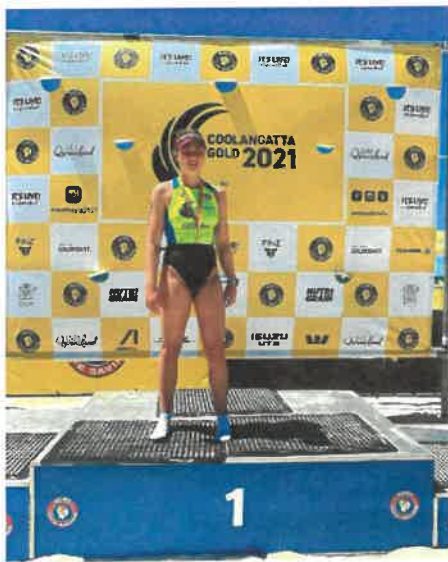


## Emu Park Surf Sports Report 2021-2022

The sporting season was off to a roaring start with both Brittany Hooton and Chloe Hooton attending the 2021 Qld Endurance champs achieving a few top 6 placings. North Aussies was the next carnival – 63 Parkies (our largest contingent in many years) headed to Mackay in late October. We brought home some silverware (first time in quite a while) – Handicap Trophy and 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall. **#ProudParkie**

Our North Aussies success was quickly followed by success down the other end of the State at the 2021 Coolangatta Gold. ### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 APRIL 2022

#### NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission Act 2012. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

**a. Income Tax**

The association is exempt from Income Tax in terms of Section 50-40 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997 as amended.

**b. Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)**

Property, Plant and equipment are carried at cost where applicable.

Plant and equipment is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association.

**c. Impairment of Assets**

At the end of each reporting period, the entity reviews the carrying amounts of its tangible and intangible assets to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have been impaired. If such an indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs to sell and value in use, is compared to the asset's carrying amount. Any excess of the asset's carrying amount over its recoverable amount is recognised in the income and expenditure statement.

**d. Provisions**

Provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

**e. Cash and Cash Equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at call with banks, and other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.

**f. Revenue and Other Income**

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable after taking into account any trade discounts and volume rebates allowed. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest method, which for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument. Dividend revenue is recognised when the right to receive a dividend has been established.
